**Children's Sunday School Lesson  
October 16, 2011**

The Sunday School lesson today begins a series of lessons about Moses. Today's lesson (Exodus 1:1-2:10) is about the birth of Moses. 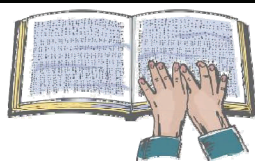

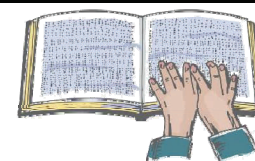
